

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Executive Committee of the UCCI met in Tiberias at the Church of Scotland Sea of Galilee Centre, Tiberias on 4 November 1985.

PRESENT: Ray Register (Chairman); Chuck Kopp (General Secretary); Sallie Lanier (Treasurer); Bob Livingston (Recording Secretary); Bertha Swarr (UCCI NEWS Editor); Shlomo Drori; Suhail Ramadan; Walter Riggans; Janette Ross; Eleanor Walker.

APOLOGIES were received from Rizik Srouji who was unable to attend.

Shlomo Drori opened the meeting by leading us in a time of prayer.

85/47 TREASURER'S REPORT: The September and October Treasurer's reports were presented. After a brief discussion it was moved and seconded to accept the Treasurer's Reports. MOTION PASSED.

The Treasurer next presented the 1985-86 proposed budget. After a lengthy discussion the proposed budget was approved as amended for presentation to the Annual Conference.

There was a discussion about the Clipping Service. The Chairman appointed a committee of Chuck Kopp, Sallie Lanier, and Bob Livingston to study the costs; possibilities of increasing the subscriptions; etc. of the Clipping Service.

8/51 PUBLICATION REQUEST: Menahem BenHayim is to bring a request for the publication of his book Jews and Gentiles in Hebrew to the Committee. He will also suggest ways of distribution, needs for the book in Hebrew, and any other pertinent information.

There was a discussion concerning funds to help with the expenses of an Arabic hymn book. Suhail Ramadan will see Josef Oudi to obtain an official request for these funds.
